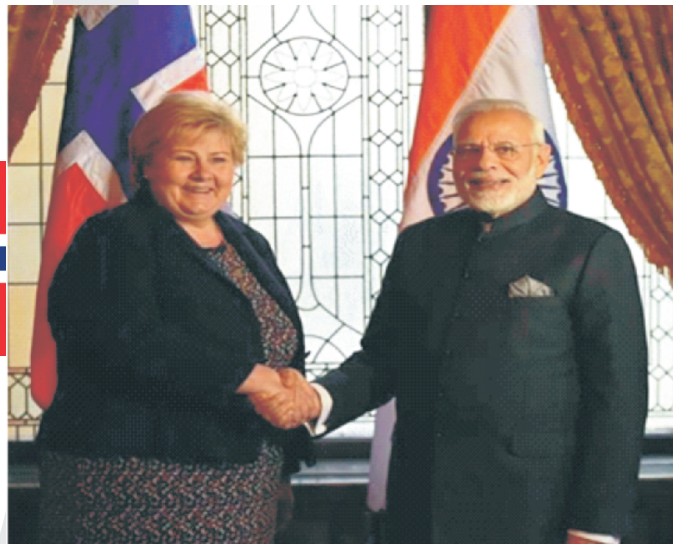

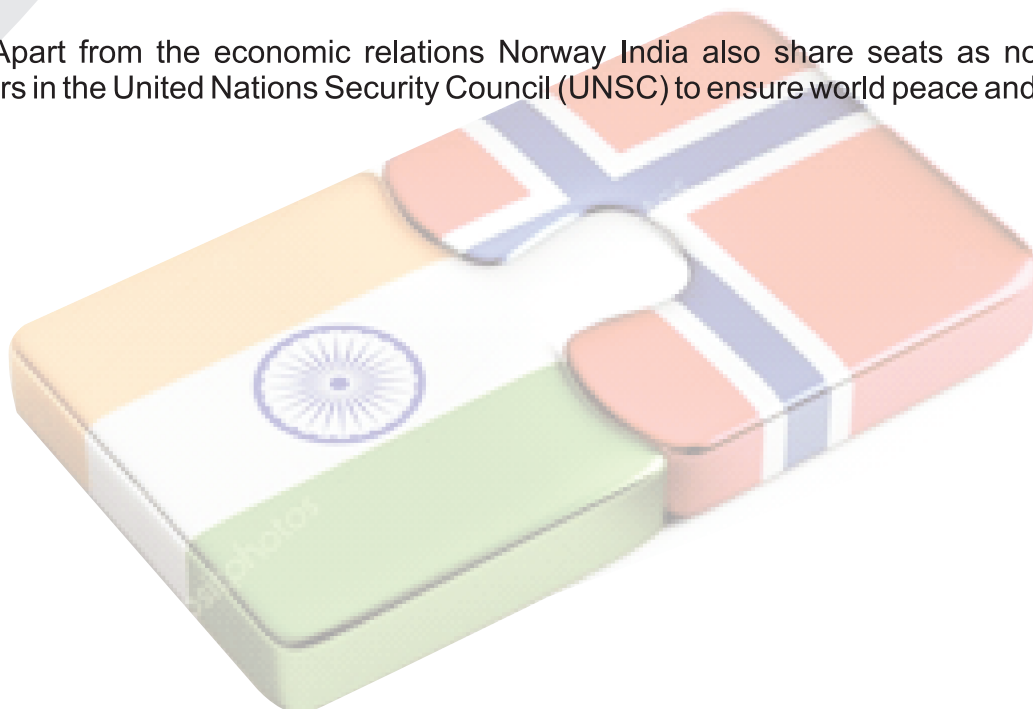


Norway – India Relations:

The tie up between Norway & India has been growing, there has been a positive trend in the activities related to trade and investments, many existing sectors like oil & gas, fertilizers, chemicals, food processing, service sector, marine, maritime, shipping , manufacturing, hydrogen, renewable energy, non-ferrous metal etc. have already been established and many new sectors like Electric Vehicles, IT, etc. are opening up.

Currently there are around 25 Norwegian companies that have set up manufacturing facilities in India. Apart from the economic relations Norway India also share seats as non-permanent members in the United Nations Security Council (UNSC) to ensure world peace and security.
